#### PATTERNS

- A pattern is a sequence of shapes, numbers, or objects that repeat in a specific order.
- Patterns are an important part of math as they help us to identify relationships, make predictions, and solve problems





### OBJECTIVES

## • The students will be able to form simple patterns using numbers and shapes







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#### **PRE-REQUISITES**

- Set of pattern
   blocks like
   rectangle, square,
   triangle, etc.
- Worksheet print out







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#### **ACTIVITY 1**:

- Give each student a set of pattern blocks (shapes such as triangles, squares, hexagons, and diamonds)
  Call out a simple pattern, such as "triangle, square, triangle,
- Call out a simple pattern, such as square".
- Have students use their pattern blocks to recreate the pattern.
- Continue calling out patterns of increasing difficulty, such as "diamond, hexagon, diamond, hexagon" or "square, triangle, diamond, square, triangle, diamond".
  For an extra challenge, ask students to create their own
- For an extra challenge, ask stude patterns for others to solve.







#### **ACTIVITY 2:**

- Create a set of number pattern puzzles using a sequence of numbers (such as 2, 4, 6, 8, 10) and a set of blank spaces.
- Have students fill in the blank spaces to complete the pattern, such as "12, 14, \_, \_, 20".
- Increase the difficulty by using more complex number patterns or by having students create their own number patterns for others to solve.
- For an extra challenge, ask students to explain the rule for each pattern and justify their answer.
