



Introduction:

- Gather the students in a group.
- Explain to the students what the activity is going to be.
- Provide understandable explanations to the students regarding the terms such as "circle", "radius" and "diameter".

Objective:

• To teach the students about circles.

Pre-Assessment:

- Level-1 Ask the students what a circle is and who to recognise them.
- Level-2 Ask the students about the properties of a circle and ask them about radius and diameter.

LEVEL-1

Materials Required: A4 sheets

Activity:

- Cut the papers into circles with different diameters.
- Ask the students to match the circles using the circumference of the circle.
- The student who matches the highest number of circles wins.





LEVEL-2

Materials Required: A4 sheets, compass, crayons/color pencils

Activity:

- Firstly, teach the students how to draw a circle using a compass.
- Then ask the students to draw a circle and create a symmetrical pattern inside it.
- Later ask them to colour it.

Post-Assessment:

- Ask the students to sit in a circle.
- Then ask them to point out things that they find in circle shape inside their classroom.
- Ask the students to clean up their supplies.









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
