

# MONEY (RUPEES AND PAISE)



### Introduction:

- Gather the students in a group.
- Explain to the students what the activity is going to be.
- Provide understandable explanations to the students regarding the terms such as "money", "rupees" and "paise".
- Tell them about various denominations of coins and notes.

### Objective:

- Teach the students about money and how an expenditure is calculated.
- By the end of the session, the students will be able to calculate their expenditure on various items.

**Pre-Assessment:** Ask the students how many paise makes a rupee. Based on the level of understanding, categorise the students into level-1 and level-2.

**Pre-Requisites:** Colored paper to create currency notes and coins, white board, white board marker

### LEVEL-1

#### **Activity:**

 Ask the children what their favourite things are and how much does it cost and how will they pay to buy it

 Now give the students previously created currency notes and coins and ask them to match it with the amount they said earlier.

#### Post-Assessment:

• Ask the students what snacks they eat in a day and how much they spend.





## LEVEL-2

#### Activity:

- Use the colored paper to make currency notes of different denominations.
- Split the class into 2 groups. Sellers and buyers
- Create an imaginary market where the sellers sell imaginary products to the buyers and the buyers buy products from them using the money(coloured paper)

#### Post-Assessment:

- Ask the students to make paper currency with various denominations.
- Then ask them to add them all up.
